



2017 Bar Exam Scholarship Announcement

Deadline: Application must be received by Friday, August 18, 2017

The Korean American Bar Association of San Diego (KABA-SD) will award two (2) \$1,000.00 scholarships to eligible individuals to take or re-take the California State Bar examination. The scholarship amount will assist in covering the cost of the Bar Exam and is *not* restricted to Koreans or individuals of Korean descent.

To be eligible for a scholarship, an individual must:

- 1) Meet the requirements for taking and will be taking the February 2018 or July 2018 California State Bar Exam;
- 2) Currently attend or have graduated from any accredited law school in San Diego County;
- 3) Be a paid member of KABA-SD (applicant may join KABA-SD at the same time as applying for this scholarship); and
- 4) Be available to attend KABA-SD's Annual Dinner, scheduled for the evening of Thursday, September 7, 2017 (date subject to change), at the Coronado Community Center, located at 1845 Strand Way, Coronado, CA 92118, to accept the scholarship (*event registration fee will be waived for recipient*).

Selection factors include but are not limited to the following criteria:

- 1) Academic achievement, work experience, activities, and post law school goals;
- 2) Demonstrated leadership and commitment to community service, particularly to the Korean and Korean American community and other diverse communities; and
- 3) Financial need.

Finalists will be selected and notified by the KABA-SD Scholarship Committee for a phone interview to occur sometime the week after the deadline, with ultimate selection to occur by the end of August.
